FAQ - Master in Spanish Language and Culture Program

How likely is it that my visa will be approved?

Student visas have undergone changes in 2025, and BLC Spain's programs are strongly positioned for success. Our Master's program is offered through a higher education institution (Universidad Europea del Atlántico), which provides greater stability and flexibility for visa approval and long-term study in Spain compared to programs through language schools.

Do I need previous Spanish language experience?

No, previous Spanish experience is not required to enroll in our Master's program. Our course begins at A1 level and is specifically designed to take students from complete beginners through to C2 mastery level over the two-year period, with initial diagnostic assessment to determine your starting point.

What if I already have some Spanish knowledge?

If you already possess some Spanish language skills, you'll complete an initial diagnostic assessment to determine your appropriate starting level within our structured progression. Our flexible incorporation system allows you to join at the appropriate level for your current competency.

How long does the visa process take?

The visa process can vary depending on your nationality and specific circumstances. Typically, it can take anywhere from 2 to 4 months from application submission to approval. We provide dedicated support throughout this process to ensure all paperwork is correctly completed and submitted in a timely manner.

Can I work while studying?

Our university-backed program allows students to work up to 30 hours per week alongside their studies. This provides excellent opportunities to practice your Spanish in professional settings, gain valuable work experience, and supplement your income during your two years in Spain. We provide guidance on work regulations and opportunities.

What are the main costs involved?

The main costs include the Master's program tuition fee (€7,900 for two years), visa application fees, health insurance coverage (required), flight costs, and living expenses in Madrid. Our programs are transparent about all costs, and we provide detailed budgeting advice to help you plan effectively for your two-year stay.

Is there flexibility in the program structure?

The program offers weekly admission and flexible incorporation based on your initial level assessment. However, to receive the full Master's degree, students must complete both Year 1 (Diploma) and Year 2 (Master's) consecutively - gap years between the two phases are not permitted.

What CEFR levels will I achieve?

Year 1 covers A1-C1 levels, and Year 2 focuses on B2-C2 levels. By completion, most students achieve C2 level proficiency - the highest level of the Common European Framework of Reference, indicating near-native competency in Spanish language and deep cultural understanding.

Admission Requirements



Non-EU Passport Holder

This program is designed for non-EU citizens who require a student visa to live and study in Spain for an extended period.



University Degree Required

You must hold an official Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification, as this is a postgraduate Master's program through UNEATLANTICO.



Commitment to Two-Year Program

Students must complete both years consecutively to receive the Master's qualification. The Diploma is only granted to students who exit after Year 1, and gap years between phases are not permitted.

- Admission Process:** Submit your online application with academic documentation, participate in a review process and suitability interview with our admissions team, receive your official admission letter and tuition invoice. Weekly admission allows for flexible start dates based on your level assessment.
